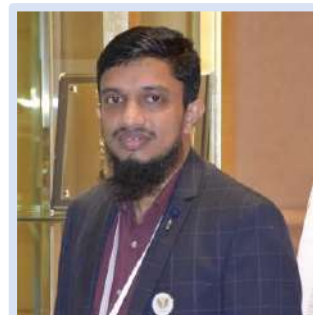

Koode Flagship project of Calicut University under NSS cell for the academic year 2019-20. The main purpose of this project was to find children who were neglected by the society, who are facing mental, physical, social and family challenges, Support and keep them alive by giving them the support they need, for that create a sustainable mechanism which brings them up to the point where they can succeed in their life.



After announcing the program by Calicut university, NSS unit no.177 of Ansar Arabic College Valavannur decided to initiate the program in October 2019. The advisory committee of the unit conducted a meeting and discussed the merits of the project and decided to initiate necessary steps.

Then we initiated a talk with the authorities of MA Moopan school for Special Needs under the Miles (Moopan Institute for Local Empowerment) Kalpakanchery the Grama Panchayath though include adopted village of NSS unit (no.177) . We focussed the mentally and physically challenged children who were in our adopted village Kalpakanchery. NSS Unit and Moopan School formed a one-year special plan. As part of the project various activities were planned under the leadership of NSS volunteers for the students of different classes.

Project Implementation

1. Volunteer training

Contacted One day training was organized for all the volunteers in the unit under the Wiles Lining Department for the successful implementation of the project.

2. Launching

The project was launched in the first week of November 2019 in Moopan School. As part of the project launch, volunteers interacted with children in the school and prepared a detailed data bank. The launching program was led by Program Officer Dr..Mohammad Rafi. C, school principal Jyothi and counsellor Zuhrabi.



3. Inauguration of kooda

The project 'Kooda' of the year 2019-20 was inaugurated by the Minister of Higher Education, Sri .K.T.Jaleel. We have received a guest who indicates the importance of the project itself.



In his inaugural address, Minister told about the importance and seriousness of the support that should be given to the marginalised ones especially to the children. And then he shared his pleasure on put forwarding this kind of a project by University of Calicut.

College Principal Prof.C.Ashraf,NSS Program Officers Dr.C.Mohammed Rafi, Dr.A.I Abdul Majeed and volunteers were participated in the function.

4. Programes with koodo

As part of the project, volunteers visited the school once in every two weeks and kept constant contact with the children. They spend time with them and always work for their up liftment.

5. Impact

Since the implementation of this project, a miraculous change has taken place among the volunteers. Compassion, more interaction with others, compassion for the neglected and ready to stand up for the various sections of the society who are facing challenges, all these are the benefits of this project.



6. Children's Day @ Koode

NSS conducted Children's Day as a part of the "Koode" project on November 14, 2019. The NSS unit was able to bring children with mentally challenged, children of the nearest aided school and the children of Anganwadi together to run as a magnificent program. It was

an unforgettable sight to see the students of different levels playing, singing and dancing together.







7. Medical camp for children

Meaningful project carried out by the NSS unit was the One-day medical camp for children, which was conducted as part of the special camp in December 2019. The main aim of the camp was to identify different types of diseases which were affecting children and suggest primary or permanent solutions to them.

The medical camp included expert counseling and specialized awareness classes for the disabled children in collaboration with the Department of Ophthalmology in Almanar Eye Hospital Tirur, Paravanna CMC Clinic Central Department and with Tirur Government Hospital.



The camp was led by experts Dr. PP Abdul Malik, Dr. Surayya, Dr Abdul Majeed, Dr Shanavas, Zuhrabi, Firos and program officer Dr. Mohammad Rafi and volunteers. Hundreds of children and parents became part of the camp.

A house at Tirur Municipality, which was devastated by the heavy floods in Kerala in August 2019,



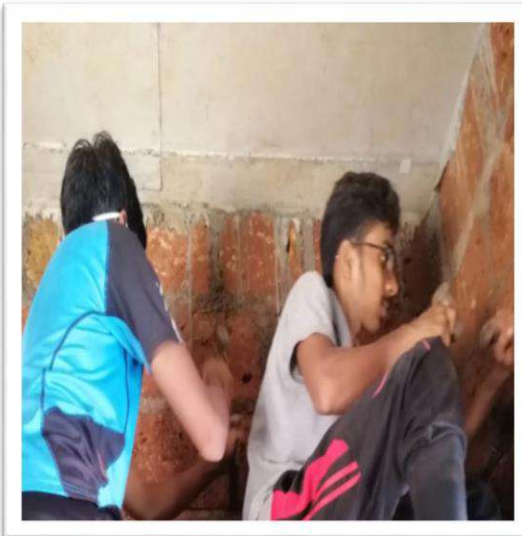
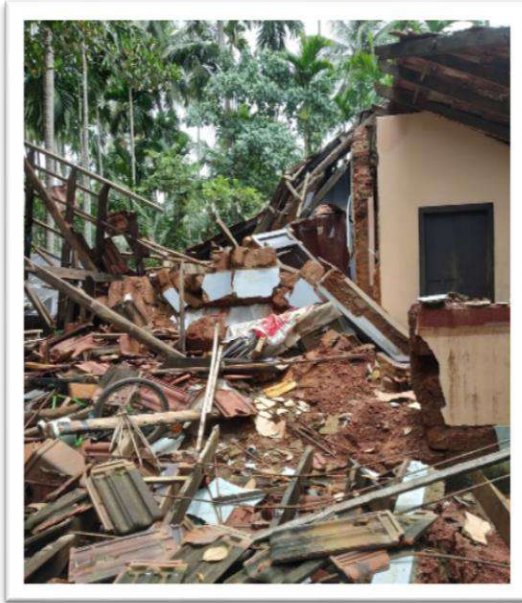

Introduction

Kerala is facing a heavy flood for the second time in the unstoppable rain of August 2019, before curing the wounds of flood disaster during 2018. The Malayalee community was ready to face this flood in a better and faster way with the same mind and the same body, putting aside all differences by erasing the caste creed and other societal hierarchies.

When Kerala faced this major crisis, the disaster affected mainly in the hilly and coastal areas of Malappuram district in particular. This horrible disaster has devastated Kavalappara at nilambur in malappuram district and grabbed their life terribly. In this context, the Ansar Arabic College NSS unit has formulated some exemplary action plans. They mainly focused on the active participation of helping the needy hands for the affected area.



1. Awareness campaign

The program officer Dr Mohamed Rafi has given the charge of Nodal officer and 25 volunteers are there to assist him for implementing the plans.

2. Volunteers Training

Different volunteer campaigns have conducted in various stages in order to train the volunteers for their enthusiastic participation on the onset of disasters and dangers.



3) SERVICES IN RELIEF CAMPS

More than 100 relief camps had operated during the flood and related natural calamities occurred in the month August of the year 2019 in Tirur Taluk in which Ansar Arabic College is situated.

NSS volunteers had registered in the relief camps which were regulated by RDO of Tirur. The services of our volunteers were exemplary and praiseworthy in the camps at Edakkulam GMLP School and Navamukaunda Higher Secondary School of Tirunavaya Panchayath, Breeze auditorium of Valavannur Panchayath, SSM Poly Technique College and Govt. Boys Higher Secondary School of Tirur Municipality, and Alathiyur Kunhumammed Haji Memorial Higher Secondary School of Triprangode Panchayath.



4. MEDICAL SERVICES IN RELIEF CAMPS

NSS members had performed praiseful services in the medical camps conducted in the relief camps under Wisdom Medical Health Care which is running centrally at Chemmad.

5. COLLECTION OF ESSENTIAL COMMODITIES

An association had formed under National Service Scheme of Ansar Arabic College ,Valavannur for collecting necessary commodities to the relief camps operating in Tirur Taluk.

Through this campaign of NSS volunteers ,the commodities were collected from the public ,voluntary organizations etc.The commodities worth 2 lakhs rupees consist of clothes ,food items ,medicines,students kits,bedsheets ,utensils ,sandals etc. had collected from different areas and these were distributed under the leadership of responsible persons in different camps.



6. ELECTRONIC APPLIANCES REPAIRING CAMP

With the co-operation of different voluntary organizations NSS unit of Ansar Arabic College had conducted a repairing camp of damaged electronic appliances as a help towards the families dragged into a miserable condition due to the sudden flood occurred .Activities of NSS volunteers were ideal.



7. RELIEF ACTIVITIES IN NILAMBUR KAVALAPPARA AND PATHAR

Nilambur Kavalappara is a region which was witnessed a landslide in the flood of 2019 and an area that had faced a lot of casualties and flow off of many houses ,disappearance of an area with shops etc.NSS unit of Ansar Arabic College also took part in the services for these disaster affected area.Our attention was in regulation of mental depression of those families and to provide them console and relief .

1) FIELD SURVEY

A survey had organized to know about the needs of peoples in the wards 10,11,12 of Purathur Grama Panchayath those who had affected the flood severely. Through this survey, we could executive action plans by understanding the basic needs of the people.

2) COLLECTION CENTRE FOR COMPASSIONATE

A collection centre had started in the college under volunteers as per the survey report. Through volunteers school kits, dresses, food items etc were collected.

3) COLLABORATION WITH CO-OPERATIVE BANK VALAVANNUR

Co-operative Bank Valavannur came forward as a support to the efforts for Purathur village by NSS volunteers of Ansar Arabic College Valavannur. Thus the bank collaborated and NSS unit could distribute food kits to 250 families, school kits for the students of poor people, Onakkodi to the elder ones as gift for Onam festival.



NSS volunteers organize a training class for making paper pens in EMALPS PARAVANNUR.

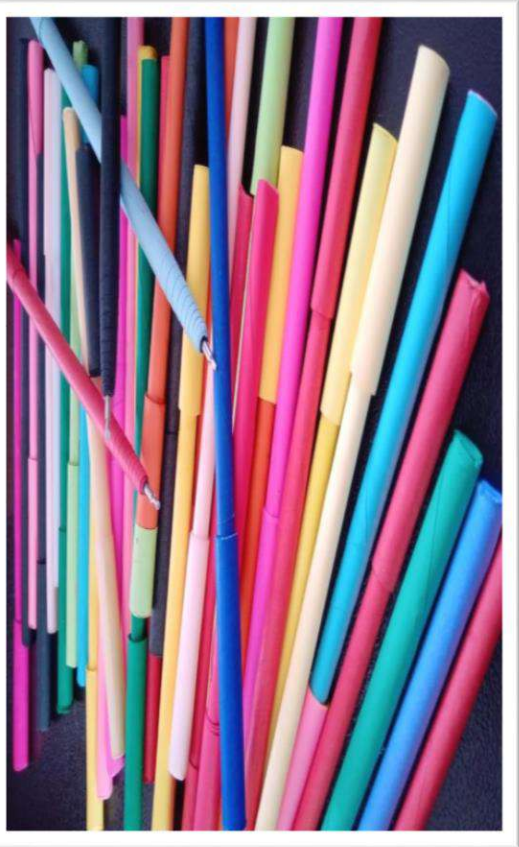
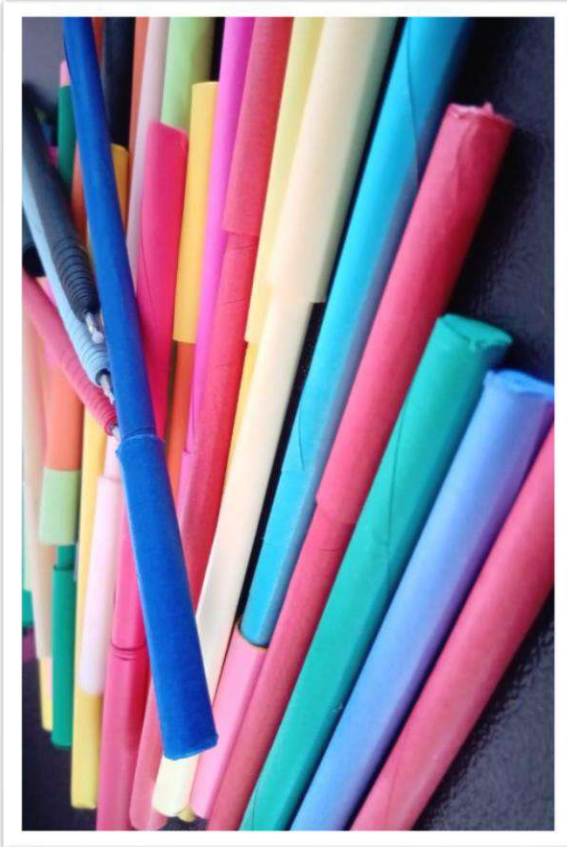
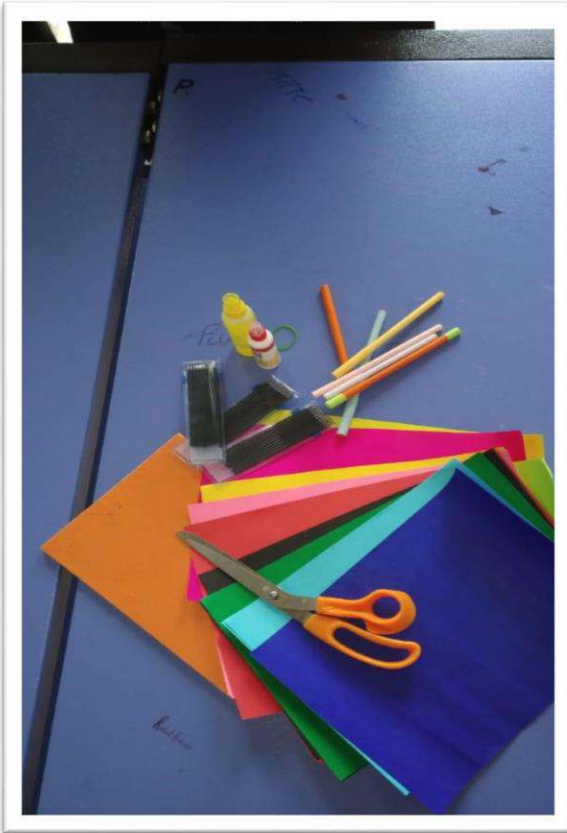
As a part of training class NSS volunteers make 100 paper pens and distribute to the students of EMALPS PARAVANNUR .

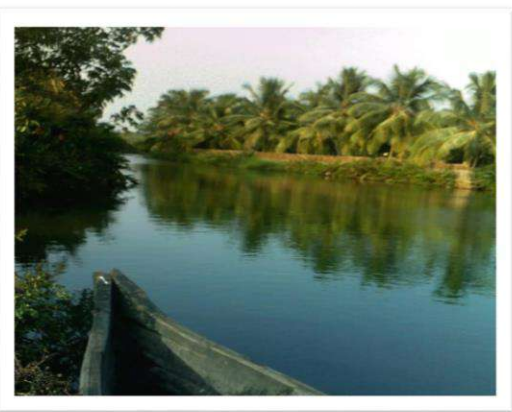
3. Photography competition

Program Officer Dr Mohamed Rafi presided over the function.

DAY-2

DAY-3

The volunteers were divided as 6 groups and went to among VETTOM Village peoples to do the survey of ANERT renewable energy and make them aware of plastic free . We became ideal and personally motivated by socially involving and serving the people . We spread the idea of plastic eradication and gave the awareness of plastic reducing, reusing and recycling we successfully completed the ANERT Survey also. It gave us a chill feel although the severity of the heat environment.





DAY-4

It was conducted as four divisions as diagnosing eye and dental patients, general medicine and counselling. Hundreds of children were reached there for the free medical assist. The expedition arrived at Agra station at 10 am on February 20 at the end of two - day journey, giving us a good idea of what a train journey can be.

The Ansar team arrived at Agra Fort for their first visit, which is one of the most important architectural highlights of Shah Jahan's reign. From there, Agra Fort special Travel Guide Arun Kumar joined us.



The team spent a lot of time at the fort, seeing the way in which many different ideas were implemented in the fort to beat the technology of modern times and marveling at its beauty.

After visiting the Agra Fort, the next stop was to see the Taj Mahal, one of the wonders of the world that has always amazed traveller's in Agra, where air pollution is rampant, regular taxis were allowed only up to a kilometer away to preserve the whiteness of the Taj Mahal, enjoyed the beauty of the Taj Mahal in the evening. At night, after a short ride through the outskirts of Agra, everyone returned to their room.



The next morning we reached Agra station and returned to Hazrat Nizamuddin station. After seeing many faces, costumes and cultures, we reached Hazrat Nizamuddin station at 8:30 am. After breakfast, the delegation arrived at Humayun's Tomb to experience the hustle and bustle of the capital city and experience the intense traffic blockage of the city.

The entire NSS team came to know about the entire Humayun's Tomb, built by Humayun's wife, Hamida Banu Begum, after realizing that the architecture of the tomb, which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is a fusion of Persian style with Indian architecture.

The next step was to take a patriotic view of every Indian citizen. After a few minutes' drive, we arrived at the India Gate, which stands head-on in the heart of Delhi.

We spent about an hour capturing those beautiful moments through the eyes of the camera in front of the India Gate, a memorial to the soldiers who



died heroically in the First World War and the Afghan War. All this time we were amazed by the security guard Amar Jawan Jyoti holding the lamp below the India Gate without a single movement.

Of the clothes worn by the stain Rajiv Gandhi at that time The collection contained relics and later returned from the museum.

After visiting the heart of Delhi and visiting many of the most famous and mysterious institutions, including the largest medical institution in India, AIIMS and JNU University. The day was falling apart.

Then back to the room. After reaching the room, many people wandered through the urban areas of Delhi for food.





For breakfast the next day,

then on the fifth day of the journey and on the third day of the first visit to Delhi, we returned to the Lotus Temple. Jamia Millia was founded in 1920. The university was founded by Maulana Muhammad Ali and Maulana Shaukat Ali .It became a central university under a law passed by the Indian Parliament in 1988. It started in Aligarh but later moved to Jamia Nagar in New Delhi. From there, we were able to learn everything. We were amazed by the vast world of Jamia Millia, which opens up endless possibilities of learning and opportunities. Jamia's campus is located in South Delhi. There are no colleges anywhere under this university. The university offers a wide range of curricula at the school, undergraduate and postgraduate levels.

Since it was Friday after a visit to Jamia Millia, he arrived at the mosque near the Sudanese Embassy for Friday prayers during the journey. After the prayers, the Ansar delegation, led by programe officer Dr .C Muhamed Rafi, had a brief chat with Palestinian Ambassador Adnan Abu Haija and had the opportunity to have a photo session with him.

Afterwards, a delicious lunch was served at the Tamil Nadu House Canteen.

The Ansar team then returned to the Gandhi Smriti Museum, where Gandhiji's memoirs were kept. Mahatma Gandhi spent the last 144 days before his assassination on January 30, 1948. The place where Gandhiji was shot dead was kept in the museum, which houses important milestones in Mahatmaji 's life.



The next destination was the Red Fort. The Red Fort, located at a radius of 2 km, overcame other forts in India. It is an extensive fort built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan. The fort was also inhabited by the Mughal rulers in the 17th century. It remained the capital of the Mughal dynasty until the capture of the Red Fort by the British Government of India in 1857 from the then Mughal ruler Bahadur Shah Zafar. The Red Fort was inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List in 2007. We spent two hours touring the sprawling fort and spending the evening at the Red Fort.

Then, on a golden evening, return to Delhi's Jumuah Masjid, which looks beautiful in the golden glow of the sunset. From there, the bustle of traders amazes every visitor's. The Delhi Juma Masjid is a non - stop spring for shopping lovers who come to Delhi. It's impossible to go back to Meena Bazaar and Chandni Chowk for hours on end. Arrived at the Delhi Metro with a travel guide to return to the room. The dream of the Delhi Metro, which is well known in India for its planning excellence and international standards. The Delhi Metro, the second underground metro system in India, was formed with the help of Malayalee E. Sreedharan, who was the Chairman of Metro Construction.



After the three days Delhi visit we returned to Kerela. The trip teach all the volunteers what is India. why it is called the country which Unity in diversity.

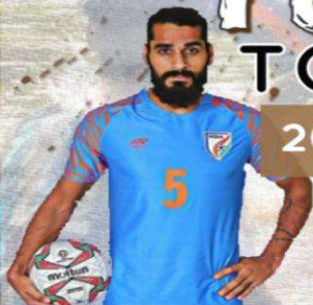
