# INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

Ansar Arabic College Valavannur Affiliated to University of Calicut 2021-22 The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Ansar Arabic College Valavannur has been functioning successfully for the last 7 years. With a focus on academic excellence to ensure quality in all operations, the core team of the IQAC include Prof. C Ashraf., Principal of the College as the IQAC Chairman, Mr. Abdurrab M, as the Coordinator and Ms. Shibila Nargees, as the Assistant Coordinator.

This report details the activities/events carried out by the IQAC in accordance with the Plan of Action that had been outlined in the previous year.

The IQAC strove to institutionalize quality assurance strategies and processes through its interventions and suggestions in the following areas:

## Submission of the Self-Study Report for NAAC First Cycle

Principal Prof. C Ashraf as the Chairman of the IQAC and Mr. Abdurabb M, IQAC Coordinator and Ms. Shibila Nargees K, Assistant Coordinator, took the lead roles in spearheading the formation of a plan of action for the preparation of the Self Study Report for the accreditation period of 5 years – 2015 to 2020. Dr. Abdul Majeed AI, the NAAC Coordinator, assisted by Mr. Abdurabb M, the IQAC Coordinator and Ms. Shibila Nargees, the Assitant Coordinator, took up the task of preparing the Self Study Report. Various committees were formed with senior teachers and members of the IQAC in charge of the seven criteria to work on the collection and compilation of data for the SSR.

An IQAC organizing committee was constituted to coordinate the preparations for the criteria wise NAAC Work. Criteria wise team leaders were constituted to coordinate the criteria documentation. An orientation class was given for the preparation of documentation and filing process.

The IQAC worked closely with the Departments and appointed NAAC Criteria teams to successfully submit the Institutional Information for Quality Assessment (IIQA) on 19 April 2021, and received the approval on 29th May 2021. The Self-Study Report was submitted on 26<sup>th</sup> July 2021. The Data Validation and Verification (DVV) process began on 7<sup>th</sup> February 2021 and the College successfully provided proofs for the queries and clarification on 22 February 2019 and received the approval on 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2022. The academic year 2021-22 is a milestone year, as the NAAC Accreditation Process under the revised frame work is going on.

The first meeting of the IQAC for the year 2021-22 held at IQAC room decided to schedule the quality assurance programs. It was also decided to distribute the teacher's diary, department diary and students tutorial register to both department heads. To ensure the quality of education, IAQC planned to prepare the academic calendar of the college and requested the faculty members to submit the necessary suggestions to the staff council. The IQAC decided to pursue SCHOLA, an office automation system, which is an IQAC initiative to record the students' information. Student's attendance should also be recorded by using the App.
