The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at Ansar Arabic College Valavannur has effectively operated for eight years, emphasizing academic excellence for overall quality. Led by Prof. C Ashraf, the College Principal, the core team includes Mr. Abdurrab M as the Coordinator and Ms. Shibila Nargees as the Assistant Coordinator. This report outlines IQAC activities aligned with the previous year's Plan of Action, focusing on institutionalizing quality assurance in various areas.

NAAC PEER TEAM VISIT

On August 23rd and 24th, 2022, Ansar Arabic College in Valavannur underwent assessment by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) Peer Team. The team, led by Chairman Prof. Yaseen Ahmed Shah and Coordinating Members including Prof. Rizvanur Rahman and Prof. Mohammad Khalil Ahmed, evaluated various aspects such as curricular activities, teaching methods, research, infrastructure, and more.

The assessment began with detailed discussions with the college's principal, Prof. C Ashraf. Meetings were held with the NAAC coordinator, Dr. Abdul Majeed A.I, and IQAC coordinator Mr. Abdurrabb M. The Peer Team engaged with IQAC, all departments, faculty, non-teaching staff, students, alumni, governing body, and parents, visiting academic and administrative facilities.

Cultural presentations by students captivated the audience. The team meticulously examined documentary evidence, prepared a comprehensive report, and conducted an exit meeting with faculty members on August 24th, 2022. The final report was handed over to the Principal.

The entire college community, including the Governing Body, Principal, NAAC coordinators, faculty, staff, students, parents, and alumni, collaborated seamlessly during the assessment. This process has allowed Ansar Arabic College Valavannur to assess and affirm its institutional capabilities.

In the first cycle of academic evaluation, the college retained its 'A' grade, achieving a CGPA score of 3.15, as determined by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC).
